This District has received an application for a Department of the Army permit pursuant to Section 10 of the River and Harbor Act of 1899 (33 USC 403), and Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (33 USC 1344). Please communicate this information to interested parties.

LOCATION OF WORK: The project is located on Mississippi Sound in Pass Christian, Harrison County, Mississippi, east of the existing harbor south of U. S. Highway 90 in Section 25, Township 8 South, Range 13 West (latitude 40.31245, longitude -89.24304).

WORK DESCRIPTION: The applicant proposes to expand the existing harbor by constructing a new basin on the east side of the existing facility. The purpose of the project is to promote economic development and to sustain the Mississippi commercial fleet by providing docking space for both commercial vessels and recreational boaters. The project is being funded through a Mississippi Development Authority Economic Development grant.

The harbor expansion project will include constructing additional piers and walkways (7 main piers, 170 finger piers), mooring piles and channel markers, boat ramps (4), a relocated "pram" beach, commercial use areas (including a fuel farm), a pump-out station, a harbormaster office,

parking lots, picnic pavilions, scenic overlooks, restrooms, and a new beach area. Specific project elements will include approximately 28 acres of new work dredging for the east harbor area (1200 feet wide by 1000 feet long); maximum dredge depth will be -10 feet MLLW for a total dredge volume of 455,000 cubic yards of material. Approximately 3200 linear feet of bulkheads will enclose the new harbor area. A navigation channel measuring 5500 feet long by 100 feet wide (13 acres) leading to the harbor area will also be dredged; maximum depth will be -10 feet MLLW for a total dredge volume of 25,000 cubic yards of material. Permanent water bottom fills will include constructing a jetty on the east side of the new harbor, a caisson breakwater located waterward of the new harbor opening, and a new parking lot; these fills will total 9.95 acres. Approximately 126,000 square feet of dredged material will be deposited along the outside of the eastern jetty to allow longshore currents to create a sand fillet (beach) east of the new harbor. In addition, approximately 10,000 square feet of dredged material will be used to relocate the existing "pram" beach to the area south of the existing yacht club building.

The applicant has applied for certification from the State of Mississippi in accordance with Section 401(a)(1) of the Clean Water Act, and upon completion of the required advertising, a determination relative to certification will be made.

Also, the applicant has applied for certification from the State that the proposed activity complies with and will be conducted in a manner that is consistent with the State Coastal Zone Management Program. A determination relative to consistency will be made by the Mississippi Department of Marine Resources.

This public notice is being distributed to all known interested persons in order to assist in developing facts on which a decision by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) can be based. For accuracy and completeness of the record, all data in support of or in opposition to the proposed work should be submitted in writing setting forth sufficient detail to furnish a clear understanding of the reasons for support or opposition. The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact, including cumulative impacts, of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit which reasonably may be expected to accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered, including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, cultural values, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, flood plain values, land use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs, safety, food production, and in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

The Corps is soliciting comments from the public; Federal, State, and local agencies and officials; Indian Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general

environmental effects, and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity. Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider this application. Requests for public hearings shall state with particularity, the reasons for holding a public hearing. Evaluation of the probable impacts involving deposits of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States will include the application of guidelines established by the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.

In accordance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, and Appendix C of 33 CFR 325, the undertaking defined in this notice is being considered for the potential to effect cultural and historic properties within the permit area. Although the extent of federal control and responsibility for these considerations are confined to the limits of the permit area for this particular project, the potential indirect effects that may occur to historic properties as a result of this undertaking are also being considered. We are seeking comment from the State Historic Preservation Officer, federally-recognized American Indian tribes, local historical societies, museums, universities, the National Park Service, and concerned citizens regarding the existence or the potential for existence of significant cultural and historic properties within the permit area. Historic architectural or archaeological investigations may be necessary to ascertain the existence of such resources. Efforts will be made through the consultation process to avoid, minimize, or mitigate any adverse effects to significant cultural and historic properties that may occur as a result of this undertaking. The district engineer remains the final decision authority.

Preliminary review of this application and the U.S. Department of the Interior List of Endangered and Threatened Wildlife and Plants indicate that the proposed activity may affect listed endangered or threatened species, or their critical habitat. Specifically, the Leatherback sea turtle (*Dermochelys coriacea*), Hawksbill sea turtle (*Eremachelys imbricata*), Kemp's Ridley turtle (*Lepidochelys kempii*), Green sea turtle (*Chelonia mydas*), Loggerhead sea turtle (*Caretta caretta*), Gulf Sturgeon (*Acipenser oxyrinchus desotoi*), the Smalltooth Sawfish (*Pristis pectinata*), and Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*) may be affected by this project.

This notice initiates the Essential Fish Habitat (EFH) consultation requirements of the Magnuson-Stevens Fishery Conservation and Management Act. The proposal would impact approximately 43 acres of estuarine substrates and emergent wetlands utilized by various life stages of red drum, Spanish mackerel, and shrimp. Our initial determination is that the proposed action may have an adverse impact on EFH or Federally managed fisheries. Our final determination relative to project impacts and the need for mitigation measures is subject to review by and coordination with the National Marine Fisheries Service and/or U.S. Department of Fish and Wildlife Service.

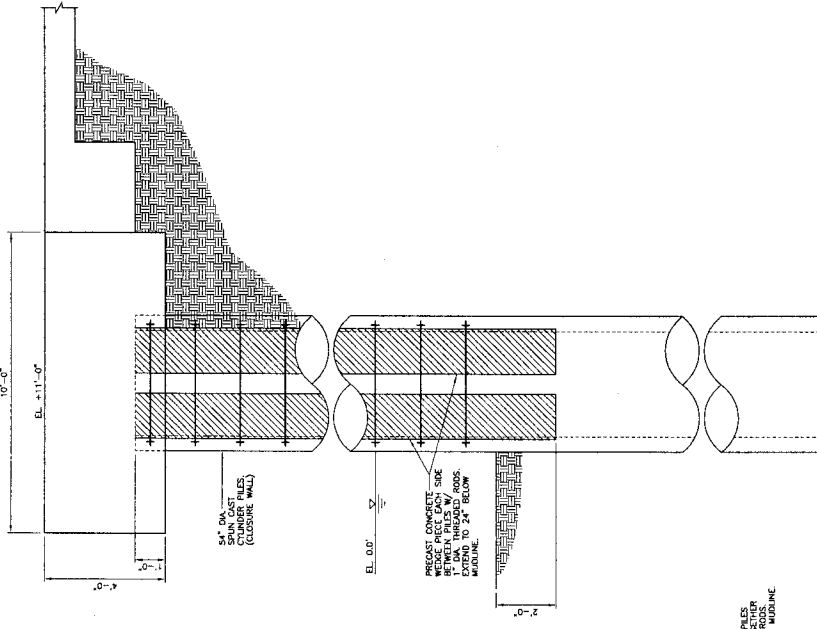

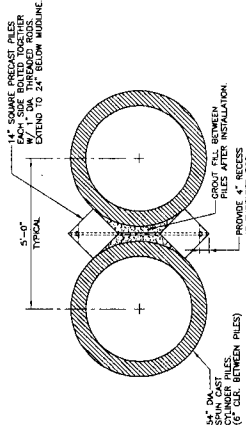
